NOTICE OF REGULAR MEETING AND PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF ASSESSMENT ROLL AND IMPOSITION OF NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 170, 190, AND 197, FLORIDA STATUTES, BY THE BALM **GROVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT**

The Board of Supervisors ("Board") of the Balm Grove Community Development District ("District") will hold a regular meeting and public hearing on September 22, 2022, at 200 p.m., at the offices of Inframark, 2005 Pan Am Circle, Suite 300, Tampa, Florida 33607.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to consider the adoption of an assessment roll and to provide for the levy, collection, and enforcement of proposed non-ad valorem special assessments ("Debt Assessments") that will secure the District's proposed special assessment bonds, to be issued in one or more series. At this hearing, the Board will hear testimony from any interested property owners as to the propriety and advisability of the Debt Assessments on all benefitted lands within the District, more fully described in the Master Assessment Methodology Report dated August 4, 2022. The proposed bonds will fund of the public improvements described in the Report of the District Engineer dated November 4, 2021 and the Report of the District Engineer dated August 4, 2022. The Board will sit as an equalizing Board to consider comments on these assessments. The public hearing is being conducted pursuant to Chapters 170, 190, and 197, Florida Statules.

The annual principal assessment levied against each parcel will be based on repayment over 30 years of the total debt allocated to each parcel. The District expects to collect sufficient revenues to retile no more than \$21,435,000 principal in debt, excluding interest; collection costs and discounts for early payment. The proposed schedule of assessments is as follows:

Failure to pay the assessments may subject the property to foreclosure and/ or cause a tax certificate to be issued against the property, either of which may result in a loss of title. All affected property owners have the right to appear at the public hearing and the right to file written objections with the District within 20 days of publication of this notice.




